1) PALLIATIVE CARE and HOSPICE CARE

Palliative care: Begins early, at any time, for people with chronic life-threatening illnesses, involves managing symptoms (pain, anxiety, cough, etc) and improving quality of life.

Hospice Care: Time frame of life expectancy \leq 6 months, terminal illness, management of symptoms with emphasis on pain control for a "dignified pain-free death." <u>Very</u> helpful for families caring for a dying person at home. Ask for a referral or contact them early!
